

Accelerating Safety Activities Program (ASAP) 2019 Fact Sheet

Program Concept

ASAP is designed to provide funding (up to \$20,000) to accelerate the advancement of safety efforts. This is an opportunity to raise the level of discussion, build on successful efforts, and expand on opportunities to deliver results. This program is designed to keep the momentum going or provide an impetus to start a larger initiative.

Eligible Participants

- FHWA Safety Focus State LTAP/TTAP Centers
- FHWA Safety Focus State DOT's

Eligible Activities

- Delivery of existing training
- Outreach workshops
- Demo safety countermeasures
- Statewide peer to peer exchanges

Project Submission Process

- Complete the ASAP application form describing the project
- All proposed projects will be submitted through the FHWA Division Office
- Multiple applications for projects that are designed to achieve a maximum benefit may be submitted per state

Project Selection

- Project proposals will be reviewed and rated by a FHWA panel of Subject matter experts
- Final approval of projects will be made by the FHWA Associate Administrator for the Office of Safety

Accountability

- Each award recipient will be required to provide the appropriate FHWA Division office with a final report when the project is completed.
- Each FHWA Division Office is responsible for **obligating the ASAP funds by September 27, 2019**

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2019 ASAP ELIGIBILITY

- Emphasis is on the three focus areas – Intersection Safety, Roadway Departure Safety, Pedestrian and Bike Safety.
- Special consideration for promoting the FHWA Proven Safety Countermeasures at the local level.
- Special consideration for encouraging Every Day Counts initiatives
